Premium Estimates

Commercial Auto Insurance premiums are based primarily on radius and type of cargo hauled. If the cargo is owned by the business, the premium will range from \$2,000 to \$3,000 per year, per power unit. If the cargo is not owned by the business and the radius is intrastate, the premium will have a midrange premium of \$4,500, and for interstate, \$7,000.
